# STOP

Please read before entering

**UNTIL FURTHER ORDER, AS A RESULT OF THE COVID-19 SOCIAL-DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS, YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER THIS COURT BUILDING UNLESS YOU:**

- are required to do so for a listed matter or you have an involvement in the proceedings;
- require face to face services of the Registry;
- are a representative of an established news-media organisation; or
- are a person who has prior approval from the Associate of the Judicial Officer hearing the matter.\*

**AND IN ANY EVENT, DO NOT ENTER THE BUILDING IF:**

- you have had close contact with someone diagnosed with or suspected or confirmed as having coronavirus (COVID-19) in the last 14 days; or
- you are feeling unwell and are experiencing any of the following symptoms – cough, fever, sore throat or shortness of breath; or
- if you have travelled and returned from overseas in the past 14 days or had close contact with another person who has returned from overseas in the past 14 days.

**Please note entry to a courtroom is subject to any order made by the presiding judicial officer which may include an order restricting the number of persons permitted in the courtroom at any time.**
