**UNTIL FURTHER ORDER, AS A RESULT OF DIRECTIONS ISSUED UNDER THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT 2005 (WA):**

**YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER THIS COURT BUILDING UNLESS:**

1. you are required to do so for a listed matter or you have an involvement in the proceedings;
2. you require face to face services of the Registry;
3. you are a representative of an established news-media organisation; or
4. you are a person who has obtained prior approval from the judicial officer hearing the matter.

**AND IN ANY EVENT, DO NOT ENTER THE BUILDING IF:**

- a) you have had close contact with someone diagnosed with or suspected or confirmed as having coronavirus (COVID-19) in the last 14 days; or
- b) you are feeling unwell and are experiencing any of the following symptoms – cough, fever, sore throat or shortness of breath; or
- c) if you have travelled and returned from overseas in the past 14 days or had close contact with another person who has returned from overseas in the past 14 days.

**Please note entry to the District Court Building is conditional on:**

- i. wearing a mask is mandatory at all times unless directed otherwise by a judicial officer;
- ii. you must comply with all Covid-19 risk minimization requirements.
- iii. entry to a courtroom is subject to any order made by the presiding judicial officer (which may include an order restricting the number of persons permitted in the courtroom at any time).
