Registrars' Powers to Approve Compromised Actions – Updated Direction

Pursuant to Rule 8(1)(e) of the District Court Rules 2005, the Chief Judge directs that applications for leave to compromise an action pursuant to Order 70 rule 10 and Order 70 r 11 of the Rules of the Supreme Court 1971:

- a) must be dealt with by a judge if the damages sum proposed to be awarded is over \$250,000; and
- b) may otherwise be dealt with by a registrar.

Any previous direction made in relation to registrars' power to deal with such applications is revoked.
